Introduction

This document sets out the Charges and other amounts payable in connection with the Facilities Access Service.

Charges in this Facilities Access Service Price List are separated into recurring Charges and nonrecurring Charges. Recurring Charges are periodic amounts which are payable in each Billing Period that a Service Element is supplied by **nbn** to RSP. Non-recurring Charges are payable only when certain activities or events occur (e.g. Co-location Activations).

Discounts, credits, rebates and waivers to Charges in this Facilities Access Service Price List may be offered from time to time, as set out in the Discounts, Credits and Rebates Annexures.

Certain provisions of this Facilities Access Service Price List may be affected by the terms of an SAU.

- (b) If RSP requests that **nbn** augment the tie cables between an Equipment Rack supplied by **nbn** to RSP, and an **nbn**[®] ODF under section 4.3.6.1 of the <u>Service Technical Specification</u> for the Facilities Access Service:
 - (i) **nbn** will provide RSP with a quotation specifying the amount of the Charge and the terms on which **nbn** will agree to perform such augmentation;
 - (ii) RSP may accept or reject **nbn**'s quotation; and

- (iii) if RSP accepts **nbn**'s quotation:
 - (A) **nbn** will perform the work requested by RSP in accordance with the quotation; and
 - (B) RSP must pay the amount of the Charge set out in the quotation.
